



If you have been affected financially by COVID and can not pay Rent or Utilities (ERA) The Emergency Rental Assistance program can help.

Eligible households have:

1. Combined household income at or below 80% of area median income
2. Someone in the household has qualified for unemployment, or has experienced a reduction in household income, incurred significant costs, or experienced financial hardship due to COVID-19
3. Household is experiencing housing instability (for example, received a past-due utility or rent notice or eviction notice, or living in unsafe or unhealthy living conditions) due to COVID-19
4. Applicant resides in the household and is on the lease

If you have been affected financially by COVID and cannot pay your mortgage the CDBG Mortgage Assistance Program can help.

Eligible households have:

1. Combined household income at or below 80% of the area median income
2. Be able to prove ownership of their residence
3. Be able to prove financial impact from the COVID-19 pandemic
4. Be behind in their mortgage payments
