## **Code Requirements**

- 1. Hen chickens (no roosters) regardless of age, may be kept on a lot or parcel of land in a residential (R-1) zone, with the exception of the multiple family residential zone (RM).
- 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to keep any chicken in a residential zone in a manner contrary to the provisions found in SMC §17.12.230.
- 3. Chickens shall be confined within a secure outdoor enclosed area which shall include a covered, ventilated, and predator resistant chicken coop.

## **Coop Requirements**

- 1. The coop shall have a minimum floor area of at least two (2) square feet per chicken.
- 2. If chickens are not allowed to roam within an enclosed area outside the coop, the coop shall have a minimum floor area of six (6) square feet per chicken.
- 3. The coop shall be located in a rear yard at least twenty-five (25) feet from any dwelling located on an adjacent lot, and the coop shall have a three (3) foot setback between the structure, enclosure and the property line.
- 4. The coop and enclosed area shall be maintained in a neat and sanitary condition.
- 5. No chicken shall be permitted to roam outside the area and/or coop if there is no enclosure.
- 6. Chicken feed shall be stored and dispensed in rodent proof and predator proof containers.
